

1. Prayer for the Vision

Scripture:

“Enlarge the place of your tent, lengthen your cords, strengthen your stakes.” – Isaiah 54:2 NIV

Reflection:

Surrender means laying aside our limited vision for God’s greater one. Building a multi-purpose building is about more than stretching our tent pegs and expanding the CLF campus. The vision is about future generations who will encounter God here and carry the presence and the Word of God throughout our community.

Prayer:

Lord, I surrender my small dreams for Your big vision. Use my time, treasure, and talent to expand Your Kingdom and leave a legacy of faith for generations to come. We know it is Your will for us to be ambassadors about Our Father’s business of equipping the saints and winning souls in our community, in Jesus’ Name.

2. Prayer for Unity

Scripture:

“I pray also for those who will believe in me through their message, that all of them may be one, Father, just as you are in me and I am in you. May they also be in us so that the world may believe that you have sent me.” – John 17:20-21 NIV

Reflection:

When we, as God’s people, unite our hearts and purpose, nothing can stop the work of God. Our unity is more powerful than our resources because it is rooted in shared faith and purpose. It is exciting to be part of making an eternal difference by equipping the saints to touch lives and impact a tenth of our community.

Prayer:

Lord, make us one in vision and in purpose. Unite our church family so that we may see Your work accomplished through us. Give me a courageous and diligent heart like Nehemiah—passionate for You to be known and glorified, in Jesus’ Name.

3. Prayer for a Heart of Generosity

Scripture:

“All the believers were one in heart and mind. No one claimed that any of their possessions was their own, but they shared everything they had.” – Acts 4:32 NIV

Reflection:

Generosity begins in the heart, not the wallet. God delights in joyful giving because it reflects His own generous nature toward me. This is my opportunity to imitate His generosity by caring about what He cares about. He asks us to equip the saints and train up the next generation.

Prayer:

Jesus, help me to hold nothing back from You. May my generosity be bold, contagious, and rooted in complete trust in Your provision. Help the whole CLF family to be of one purpose and heart like the believers in the book of Acts. Help me, Holy Spirit, to love people more, in Jesus’ Name.

4. Prayer for Equipping Leaders for Ministry

Scripture:

“The people rejoiced at the willing response of their leaders, for they had given freely and wholeheartedly to the Lord.” – 1 Chronicles 29:9 NIV

Reflection:

Jesus demonstrated that growing leaders who grow leaders is all part of each of us sharing the Word and our spiritual gift to equip the saints for the work of the ministry. It is vital that we use the time we have been given to empower the next generation to be strong and carry the good news, power, and presence of the Lord.

Prayer:

5. Prayer for Discipleship Training

Scripture:

“Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age.” – Matthew 28:19-20 NIV

Reflection:

Making disciples is Jesus' plan and command. We want to be intentional by equipping disciplined followers to live a life on mission daily to make more disciples of Jesus so that all may know the good news and bring new life to those around us.

Prayer:

Help me, Lord, to follow You and Your Word as a faithful, disciplined follower, and thank You by sharing my life and love for You with others. Give me an understanding of Your Word and the boldness to live a life on mission by sharing Your name with others, in Jesus' Name.

6. Prayer for Next Generation to Know Jesus

Scripture:

“One generation commends your works to another; they tell of your mighty acts.” – Psalm 145:4 NIV

Reflection:

Each generation of believers is called to carry the torch of truth to their generation and generations beyond. It was said of King David that, “he served his generation well,” and we want to serve our generation, as well as leave a legacy of faith to the next generation, empowering them to live for Jesus and bring many with them.

Prayer:

Lord, I surrender my heart to be like You. Teach me to see my prayers and generosity as worship, and a reflection of Your love by giving Your life for me. I pray that many disciples will be made through my generosity for generations to come, long after my days on earth. I thank You, Lord, for this opportunity to make an eternal impact by equipping the next generation to live for You all their days, in Jesus' Name.

7. Prayer for Resilience

Scripture:

“When they saw the courage of Peter and John and realized they were ordinary men, they were astonished and took note that these men had been with Jesus.” – Acts 4:13 NIV

Reflection:

The early followers of Jesus faced numerous obstacles; however, their unwavering commitment to follow the purpose and plan of bringing many into the Kingdom of God in their lifetime has proven to benefit us today.

Prayer:

Lord, help us to stand firm in perseverance (a fruit of the Spirit), as we face difficulty, resistance, criticism, and personal doubts. You are with us and have given us a vision of spiritual training and equipping in order to leave a legacy of faith in Jesus to reach our community and beyond. Help us to stand firm in sharing and giving our lives for Your glory, in Jesus’ Name.

8. Prayer for Resources and Favor

Scripture:

“And God is able to bless you abundantly, so that in all things at all times, having all that you need, you will abound in every good work.” – 2 Corinthians 9:8 NIV

Reflection:

Surrender is releasing control of what we hold tightly. Like the Israelites, we are called to bring what we have to the Lord so He can build His house through us to make an impact in our community and generations to come. Holy Spirit, reveal to me areas where I need to trust You more.

Prayer:

Lord, I surrender my resources to You. Help me to recognize all that I have belongs to You anyway. Use what I give to advance Your Kingdom and draw people closer to You, in Jesus’ Name.

9. Prayer for Love and Strength

Scripture:

“By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another.” – John 13:35 NIV

Reflection:

Scripture:

Reflection:

As we, the church, have our eyes on Jesus to please and bring Him glory, we will reflect His beauty and love to the world as the only Way, the Truth, and the Life.

Prayer:

Here am I; thank You for using me, Lord, every day in every way, for Your glory, in Jesus’ Name.
